Draft of Cable to be sent to Rt. Hon. Earl Russell re Kennedy's Speech on Friday evening, March 2, 1962, on Resuming Nuclear Testing

Makers of American nuclear policies have all along been determined to resume testing. Since the first non-political conference, the United States has been merely manoeuvring at Geneva with no intention of agreeing to a test ban. Kennedy's speech Friday evening confirms that additional nuclear tests in the atmosphere have always been the policy of the American government.

The following quotations are illustrations:

"We cannot make strides in our military preparations without testing bombs in the atmosphere as well as underground."

"Our progress is stifled without experiments in every department."

"The testing of new weapons is necessarily a part of our development process."

Only your brilliant pen can bring to the attention of the world the insincerity and shallowness of Kennedy's speech. Deceit and dissimulation have been the chief characteristics of our negotiations with the Soviets.

Arthur Dean, the Wall Street lawyer, who now heads American nuclear negotiations is a leading expert in double talk and insincerity.
